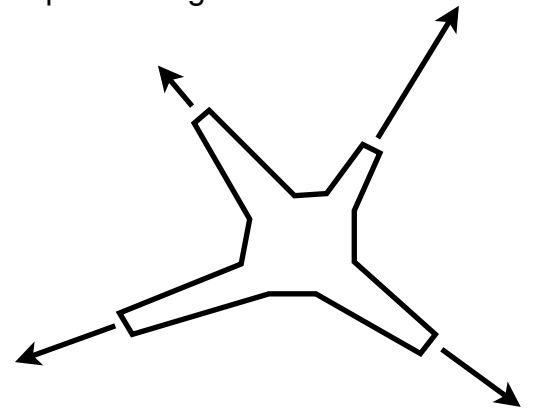


The Mounds on the Heath

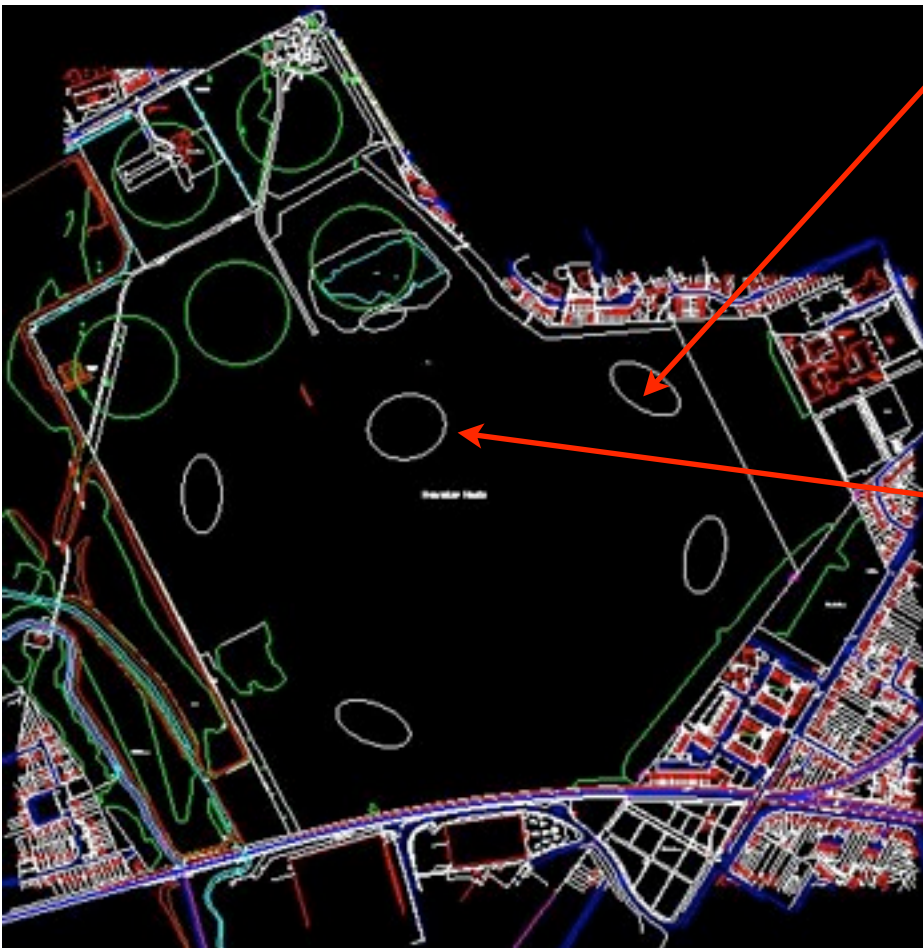
The mound to the the west of the school and mosque will be in the shape of a large crescent.



The Central Mound to be formed with the legs of each converging path forming rising individual mounds, meeting together to form a whole structure (as above).

Variants of this shape will be found at the other 3 mounds. The shapes being determined by the paths in each ones proximity.

Each mound summit will allow visibility on to the next mound and back towards the last one. This will be of great value to visitors and also great fun.



The mounds to rise gradually along the path lines as they converge. The central summit to be c.20m across. The path legs to be c. 15 - 20m in length. Graveled path surfaces will lead to the summits. All five mounds require to be seen, but not to stand out as glaring alien invaders (in the non -native plant sense). The lower 2M of each mound and the surrounding approaches to be planted with Gorse and Broom (see right). The mounds to have crescent shaped seating bays built into them (see below). The upper low plantings will be of Erica & Calluna species which are already present on the heath.
